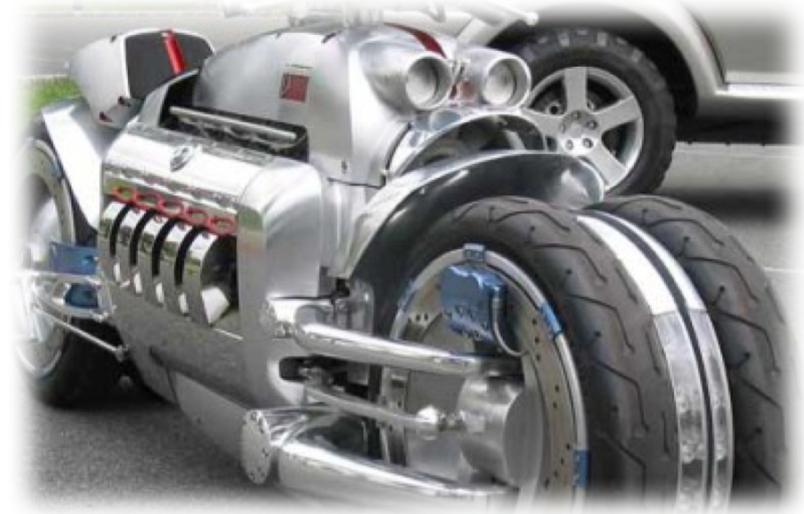


Perfil final del alumno en el mundo globalizado:

Entonces, ¿cómo se puede lograr un programa bilingüe *exitoso* en un colegio?

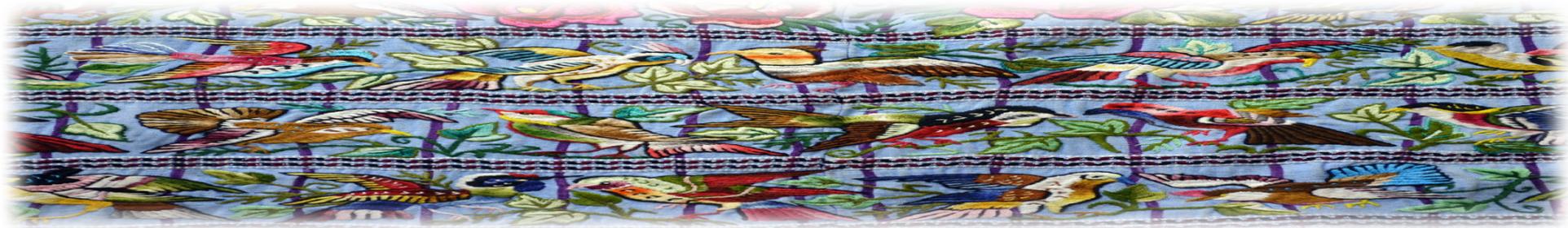


1. Determinar qué nivel de bilingüismo se busca para los alumnos
2. Definir el objetivo o perfil final (por ejemplo: TOEFL)
3. Preparar un plan de corto, mediano y largo plazo en base a la realidad alcanzable del colegio, los padres de familia, y sobre todo, de los alumnos
4. Determinar recursos materiales, humanos y financieros para llevar a cabo su proyecto de bilingüismo
5. Elaborar un sistema para evaluar a candidatos a maestros de inglés
6. Escoger un método adecuado para alcanzar el objetivo
